Aloré Design will not assume liability for labor expended, freight cost or damages accruing from the use of the material purchased from us. If material is defective, the limit of damage is the price of the defective material. Proof of purchase (original sales receipt) from the original consumer purchaser must be made available to Aloré Design for all warranty claims. The warranty is not transferable and is extended solely to the original purchaser of the product.

This warranty is for normal domestic use only and excludes defect or injury caused by or resulting from misuse, abuse, neglect, accidental damage, improper installation or improper cleaning of the product.
